

Information, according to the article 13 of D. Lgs. 196/2003 (Code about protection of personal data) and to the article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 about protection of natural persons' personal data (GDPR), about the processing of data provided by users to CREA-DC as part of the activity of seed certification and the other services offered to users

Purpose

Purpose of this note is to provide to the user of seed certification and other services, information about the use by CREA-DC of data sent through the apposite on-line software at the URL <https://crea-dc.inode.it/> or on paper as their integration.

Introduction

The seed area of CREA-DC carries out, as provided by the law about control of seed production and marketing (L. 1096/71), the control and certification of seed products for their marketing.

For regulated species, seed certification is compulsory to let seed companies sell produced seed.

Moreover, CREA-DC offers the possibility to carry out laboratory analysis, trials for varietal characterisation and other services regarding seed and varieties of agricultural and vegetable species.

Specific reference regulations about data protection and other applicatory provisions by CREA

This information note is written according to the article 13 of D. Lgs. 196/2003 (Code about protection of personal data) and to the article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 about protection of natural persons' personal data (GDPR), regarding data processing, and to CREA policy available at the URL <https://www.crea.gov.it/privacy-policy> , which we refer to for all the horizontal aspects in pursuance of the referred regulations.

Processing means and storage period of data

Personal data are processed with manual, computer-based and telecommunication means for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes which they were collected for. Specific safety measures are followed to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and not authorised access.

Data are stored on servers located in the EU territory and therefore their processing is subject to the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679.

Personal data indicated on this page are processed by CREA-DC exclusively in compliance with the purposes institutional or anyhow related to the exercise of tasks of public interest, including the purposes of the activity of seed certification or the requested services.

In case of communication of third party's personal data previously collected, CREA-DC invites the first controller who collected data to provide complete information to the concerned data subject. In any case, CREA-DC adopts the measures described in this information note for the protection of rights, freedoms and legitimate interests of every involved subject.

Data subject's rights

Data subjects can exercise the rights provided for by the article 7 of D. Lgs. 196/2003 and by the articles from 15 to 22 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016, where enforceable (right of access, right to rectification, right to erasure, right to restriction of processing, right to data portability, right to object).

Article 15 – access: you can ask for confirmation as to whether or not data concerning you are being processed, as well as more explanation about the information in this note.

Article 16 – rectification: you can ask to rectify or integrate the data provided by you, if inaccurate.

Article 17 – erasure: you can ask that your data are erased, in case they are no longer necessary for our purpose, in case of withdrawal of consent or your objection to the processing, in case of unlawful processing, or if there is a legal obligation of erasure or data refer to a person under sixteen years of age.

Article 18 – restriction of processing: you can ask that your data are processed only for the purpose of storage, excluding other processing, for the period necessary to your data's rectification, in case of unlawful processing which you oppose to erasure for, in case you have to exercise your rights in court and data stored by us may be useful to you, and, finally, in case of objection to processing pending the verification whether our legitimate grounds override yours.

Article 20 – portability: you can ask to receive your data, or to have them sent to another controller indicated by you, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format.

Article 21 – objection to processing: you can object at any time to processing of your data, unless there are our legitimate grounds for the processing overriding yours, for instance for the exercise or our defence on trial.

Article 22 – opposition to automated decision-making: you can oppose to automated decision-making, in case the controller carries out this kind of processing.
